Beaumont Wilshire Neighborhood Association

Land Use

- Monitor the following in connection with the Portland Plan
 1. Infill development
 2. Design overlay for the neighborhood
 3. High density “step-down” to lower densities
- Beaumont School learning garden – complete the storm water component
- Address the need for public art along NE Fremont
- Screening of mausoleums at the Rose City Cemetery
- NE 42nd Avenue as a retail/commercial corridor for BWNA, Cully and Concordia

Transportation

- Traffic volume and speeding issues on NE 37th Avenue
 1. Bike and pedestrian crossing at NE 37th and Fremont
 2. NE 37th and Prescott off-set intersection safety improvement
- Shared-use parking with Beaumont School

- Sacajawea Park interim improvements (\$100,000 available)
