

**CNN Neighborhood Planning Priorities**  
**January 2009 – June 2010**  
**January 5, 2009**

**Land Use**

Highest Priority

- MAX station area planning project at NE 60<sup>th</sup>, NE 82<sup>nd</sup>, and Sumner/Parkrose MAX stations (Rose City Park, Madison South, Sumner)
- Implement “Imagine 82<sup>nd</sup> Ave. (Roseway, Madison South)
- Cully land use and commercial zoning; Investigate urban renewal funding for Cully and NE 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue; small storefront development on NE 82<sup>nd</sup> Ave.
- Cully/Concordia Assessment coordination on Safe Routes to School and Zoning
- Urban Plaza in Hollywood
- Coordinate with University of Oregon and/or Portland State on a student project
- “Main Street Revitalization” on NE Sandy Blvd -NE 57<sup>th</sup> to NE 82<sup>nd</sup> Ave. (Rose City Park, Roseway)

Monitoring

- Portland Plan (on-going 3-year process); identify “20 minute communities”
- Monitor land use proposals and actions and act upon proposals that have neighborhood-wide and coalition-wide impacts.
- Ad hoc member of Save NE 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue group (Roseway, Madison South)

Other

- Attention to the sub-district area along north I-84 corridor between Hollywood and NE 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue
- Whitaker Middle School Redevelopment (Cully, Beaumont Wilshire)
- On-going coordination with Providence Medical Center (Hollywood, Rose City Park)

**Transportation**

Highest Priority

- Seek funding for NE Sandy, NE 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, and NE Killingworth transportation planning projects through MTIP, TGM and other funding sources
- Airport Futures Planning – coordinate with citizen representatives on Project Advisory Group
- Airport Way/I-205 ramp project (Sumner, Cully)
- Hollywood MAX station and transit center

Monitoring

- Review and comment on Metro Regional Transportation Plan (state version)
- Streetcar System Plan
- Airport Noise Advisory Committee
- Portland Bicycle Master Plan Update
- Sumner neighborhood traffic infiltration issues

### Other

- Participate with local CNN-area schools in Safer Routes to School/Bike Safety Education programs
- Identify locations for green corridors, pedestrian walkways, bikeways and curb cuts
- 82<sup>nd</sup> MAX Platform Community Planning Through Environmental Design

### **Parks and Open Spaces**

#### Highest Priority

- Colwood National Golf Course public acquisition (Cully)
- Sacajawea Park interim improvements (Cully)

#### Monitoring

- Sullivan's Gulch Trail committee (along south CNN border)
- Columbia Slough Trail along north CNN border

### Other

- Advocate for Gateway Green proposal along east CNN border
- Investigate a greenway corridor from Rose City Park to Glenhaven Park to Siskiyou Square to Rocky Butte Park to Gateway Green
- Investigate a green corridor connection from Thomas Cully Park to NE 72<sup>nd</sup> Avenue park blocks
- Rose City Park Elementary School community gardens
- "Sand Lot" in Sumner neighborhood

### **Neighborhood Planner Activities**

#### Staff the CNN LUTOP Committee

- Develop a list of future LUTOP speakers and presentations
- Revise LUTOP bylaws
- 2007/2008 annual progress report
- Outreach to under-represented community organizations
- Prepare agendas and meeting notes
- Organize summer field trip and spring workshop

#### Day-to-Day Planning

- Provide technical assistance to neighborhoods, business associations and members of the community
- Track public contacts via drop-ins, phone calls, letters and emails
- Get word out to diverse groups about planning activities
- Work with crime prevention staff on OLCC/alcohol and nuisance complaints
- Regular updates of Neighborhood Planning section of the CNN website
- On-going coordination with other Neighborhood Coalitions, City Bureaus and other agencies, including Port of Portland, ODOT and Metro.

#### Monthly Meetings

- Attend at least two meetings per year in each neighborhood association
- Attend business association meetings as requested or required
